Paul Cornelius Gray – White Nationalist, Neo-Nazi

Reported, from eyewitness reports, Paul has often extolled 'killing Muslims' while he was in the Army. Paul Gray was a member of the assault on political rivals of May 1, 2017, along with noted white supremacists such as William Fears, Sydney Crabtree, and Ken Reed. Associate William Fears is photographed at the event, next to Gray, displaying Nazi 'sieg heils'. Fears drew attention for an attempted murder charge for firing a weapon at a Richard Spencer ('Alt Right' personality) in Florida in October 2017. At the rally, he and his brother and another associate were seen cheering Adolf Hitler before threatening to kill a group of

political rivals at whom they fired weapons. More recently, he has been charged as a felon in possession of a firearm. At the May Day attack, at least two nonviolent protesters were attacked by the white supremacists, including one who was disabled.

May 23, 2017, Paul Gray is fired from his job at the South Congress Hotel after his violent and white supremacist ties are brought to light by Austin activists.

June 10, 2017, Paul Gray appears at the Islamaphobic 'March Against Sharia' march, promoted by the austin chapter of the Islamaphobic ACT for America group. associate Sydney Crabtree appears at the event wearing a white Ku Klux Klan robe and associate William Fears appears wearing the insignia '1488' on his helmet, a reference to the letter code for 'Heil Hitler' and the 14 word oath to the 'white race' popularized by the American Nazi Party.

June 11, 2017, Paul Gray worked 'security' at anti-gentrification protests at the Blue Cat Cafe, his sister's business, in which he and other 'security' guards stole protestors flag poles and threatened menacingly to hit their political opposition with them, One of the other security workers present was **Erick Sailors**, Central Texas leader of openly Neo-nazi organization Patriot Front. Discord (a social messaging app popular among white supremacists) shows that Sailors, a Marine veteran, was leading 'boot camp' style classes for other white supremacists in the San Marcos area. Patriot Front members were involved in the white nationalist violence in Charlottesville, and who praise Hitler and the Holocaust, as well as the actions of Dylan Roof, who was recently sentenced to death for murdering nine members of a black church in Charleston, South Carolina. He [Roof] was hoping to ignite a race war.



Members of the security detail are friends through a white supremacist weightlifting group called 'Liftwaffe' (an obvious reference to the Nazi Luftwaffe, the aerial warfare branch of the Nazi military). Far-right groups such as **White Lives Matter** and InfoWars have advised their fanbase to frequent the Blue Cat Cafe.

June 17, 2017, Paul Gray hosted a white nationalist rally at the Texas State Capital under the moniker 'Tomorrow Belongs to Texas', whose guests included Ken Reed of 'White Lives Matter', the rebrand of Aryan Renaissance Society, a Neonazi prison skinhead gang. Previous White Lives Matter rallies have included the leadership of **Atomwaffen Division**, a Neo-nazi organization

linked to at least five murders in the US, as well as bombing plots. Other attendees of the event include members of Vanguard America, which, after being photographed and filmed committing acts of racial hatred in Charlottesville, rebranded to Patriot Front, as well as members of the Neo-nazi group Traditionalist Workers Party. Attendees at the rally are seen flying 'Sonnengrad' (Nazi black sun) flags, displaying Nazi sieg heils, and hurling antisemitic slurs at political opponents. The official sponsor of the event was Republican lawmaker Matt Schaefer, known for his anti-immigrant rhetoric. The event is promoted by Neo-nazi website The Daily Stormer. The event was promoted as one in which "proud white men got up and talked about Jews and their hordes without any reservation whatsoever."

Gray's previous Facebook likes include "Feminism Is a Death Cult', 'Wehrmacht Uniforms 1939-1945', 'Breitbart News', 'Angry White Girl', and 'Counter-signal Memes for Fashy Goys' (Fascist Gentiles).

Although Gray has been keeping a low profile lately, he has been seen recently in downtown Austin threatening canvassers, particularly Women of Color, saying "ok, I'm gonna come back and hurt you".

Paul, according to his professional life, is currently working at The W in downtown Austin (owned by Starwood), in addition to Point2Point moving in Austin as well.

We have contacted both places of work, and while one has not responded as of this date, Point2Point has claimed he has never worked here, while also simulatenously saying he was associated with a previous owner, even though we can see on their corporate filings that they filed in 2012, and Gray has been working there since AT LEAST 2014.

We have also received shoddy information that he may have moved to Denver, Colorado to escape his rightfully-placed label as a violent Neo-nazi. You would think he would be proud of his "white heritage". Behold the """master race""" y'all.

For what we know currently, he has a 2005 Silver Jeep with license plate GBJ2PH and lives at address https://pastebin.com/um5ZRKH2. We have seen him walking between second street, most likely either going from home or from his job to home.
